

CAMPERSHIP PROGRAM PROCESS

- A copy of the Campership Application appears on the back of this page. Additional application forms will be available at all council offices and Scout Shops.
- Connecticut Rivers Council administered Camperships will be restricted to Connecticut Rivers Council households only, which attend a Connecticut Rivers Council Camp Program, subject to available funding.
- Applicants are to complete an application and attach a photocopy of one of the following supporting documents as income and family status certification: (*please block out social security numbers*)
 - Last IRS Form 1040 filed, first page only
 - State or Federal Documentation of unearned income (AFDC, SSO, SSA, Unemployment Compensation, WIC)
 - A current letter from the agency is required to confirm eligibility.
- Families who are eligible for Free or Reduced School Meals may be eligible for campership consideration.
- Regardless of Family Adjusted Gross Income, if there are current extenuating financial situations, applications will be accepted with a detailed statement of explanation along with the above indicated documents.
- Applicants are asked to forward applications and verification documents in a sealed envelope to the Campership Review Panel at the council office at 60 Darlin Street, East Hartford, CT 06128-0098 for review and processing.
- Unit Leader verification is not required.
- Campership application process will be solely between applicants and the Campership Review Panel, supporting family confidentiality.
- Unit leader will be advised of Camperships pending and awarded, as to support unit accountability throughout the camp registration process.
- Campership applicants are advised not to forward final payment until notice of campership award has been announced on or around June 15th.
- All qualified applicants will be afforded the base camper fee in respect to their individual camper fee, without regard for their campership awarded.
